

9-SQUARE IN THE AIR

1. The person in the center square (the top cat or other suitable title) serves the ball to any other square by hitting the ball up and out of the top of their square and through the top of another square.
2. Players return the ball, by hitting it into another player's square up through the top of their square.
3. If a player fails to return the ball to another player's square (when the ball goes out of bounds before going through a square), that player is out and moves to the end of the line.
4. During game play, players are not allowed to touch the game structure (the PVC pipes). Touching the game structure can* result in the player being out and going to the end of the line. (*The rule should be decided on before play begins.
5. A double hit (two hits in a row) results in the player being out and going to the end of the line.
6. When a player is out, they leave their square and move to the end of the line. The other players advance to fill the square of the player who just got out.
7. One objective is to advance to the center square.
8. A cooperative objective could be to see how many times the ball can be hit (within the guidelines) before anyone is out.
